REVIEWING PROCESS

- 1. All manuscripts will be subjected to single-blind peer-reviewing and are expected to meet the scientific criteria of novelty and academic excellence.
- 2. The corresponding author is responsible for ensuring that the article's publication has been approved by all other co-authors and takes responsibility for the paper during submission and peer review.
- 3. The submitted full paper will be reviewed by two independent reviewers for:
 - 3.1. Suitability for one of the topics of the conference;
 - 3.2. Scientific content and level, the relevance of presented results;
 - 3.3. Comprehensibility, conciseness and clarity of presentation;
 - 3.4. Correspondence with the template, language usage, and grammar.
- 4. Reviewers declare no conflict of interest or other ethical conflict with the articles they review. Within 7 days, any of the appointed reviewers may refuse to review the submitted paper. In case of refusal, another reviewer is appointed. The deadline for submitting reviews is 15 days.
- 5. The reviewer's comments and notes will be communicated to the corresponding author and corrections may be required to be made and the revised article resubmitted before the prescribed deadlines.
- 6. Each reviewer makes a recommendation for acceptance, the need to correct or reject the article.
- 7. When one of the reviewers recommends acceptance and the other rejects the article, a senior reviewer is appointed. The senior reviewer's recommendation is final.
- 8. All accepted papers must be presented during the conference before being published.
